Participation: *To promote Swimming New South Wales meetings and represent the Area at Swimming New South Wales meetings and forums by:

- a) Providing financial support to promote face to face attendance at meetings and forums
- b) Encouraging club delegates to attend meetings and forums

Performance: *To deliver a development program that suits the needs of our Area and state requirements by:

- a) Planning and organisation by the SNC Development Committee and SNC Development Officer
- b) Adopting a holistic approach to athlete development
- c) Providing a range of competitive programs within the Area
